Government Relations Report The oral report presented by Steve Windom concerning the upcoming legislative session was received as information.

MINUTES

Public Minutes of December 11, 2019 The Credentials Committee recommended that the Public Minutes of December 11, 2019, be approved. The motion was adopted without objection.

CURRENT BUSINESS

Proposed Administrative Rules

Administrative Rules 540-X-3-.01, .09 and .11 – Licensure Requirements, Forms and Fees
The Credentials Committee recommended that Administrative Rules 540-X-3-.01, 540-X-3-.09, and 540-X-3-.11 be published for public comment in the *Alabama Administrative Monthly*. The motion was adopted without objection.

Applicants for ABME Review – Licensure Processes After consideration of a memorandum from Licensing Director Ashley Hamlett, the Credentials Committee recommended that the

licensure processes be approved. The motion was adopted without objection. A copy of the memorandum shall be made a part of these Minutes and shall be attached hereto as Exhibit A.

FSMB Strategic Plan Report – Call for Comments The Credentials Committee recommended that this item be received as information. The motion was adopted without objection.

International Society of Hair Restoration Surgery The Credentials Committee recommended that this item be received as information. The motion was adopted without objection.

Investigative Committee – Case Review The Credentials Committee recommended that the Investigative Committee be approved to assign certain investigative cases for chart review to Board members other than those who serve on the Credentials Committee. The motion was adopted without objection.

MAT Working Group The Credentials Committee recommended deferring a report to be presented to the full Board.

The oral report presented by Amanda J. Williams, M.D., was received as information. A copy of the Minutes of the January 7, 2020, meeting of the MAT Working Group shall be made a part of these Minutes and shall be attached hereto as Exhibit B.

Medical Digest After consideration of a discussion to solely distribute the *Medical Digest* electronically, the Credentials Committee recommended that, prior to fully transitioning to an electronic version of the *Medical Digest*, a notification be sent to all recipients allowing them the option to continue to receive a printed copy, that a notice be placed in the next volume of the *Medical Digest* alerting readers of the transition, and, that after the transition to electronic

format, each volume continue to be posted to the agency's website. The motion was adopted without objection.

The Credentials Committee further recommended that an article be drafted concerning retired physicians and the requirements associated with maintaining a license. The motion was adopted without objection.

Office-Based Surgery Guidelines: Ultrasound Guided Egg Retrieval After consideration of the question, "Should a physician who is performing ultrasound guided egg retrieval with minimal sedation be required to register for office-based surgery?", the Credentials Committee recommended that the Board issue the opinion that a physician performing office-based ultrasound guided egg retrieval should register as a provider of office-based surgery. The motion was adopted without objection.

Opioid Overdose and Addiction Council Annual Report The Credentials Committee recommended that the report be received as information. The motion was adopted without objection.

Resolution: Authority to Transact Business The Credentials Committee recommended approving the Resolution for the Authority to Transact Business and removing the authority to transact the financial business of the Board from previously approved former employees. The motion was adopted without objection. A copy of the resolution shall be made a part of these Minutes and shall be attached hereto as Exhibit C.

SHPDA: OBS Review Process After consideration of correspondence from the Medical Association of the State of Alabama, the Credentials Committee recommended that the Board's

legal staff be approved to engage in conversation with the parties in this matter and that a report be brought back to the Board. The motion was adopted without objection.




