The motion was adopted.

2007 Legislative Packet The Credentials Committee recommended approval of the proposed legislative amendments to §34-24-51 and 34-24-361. The Committee further recommended approval of the proposed amendments to 34-24-70, 34-24-337 and 34-24-340, as amended by the Committee. The Committee also recommended proposing legislation to provide for the voluntary surrender of a P.A. license and to propose language to provide for the hearing of, and jurisdiction of, any request to reinstate said P.A. license. The motion was adopted. A second motion was made to refer the seven year time limit for taking the USMLE to staff for further research to be presented to the Board at a later date.
