Any subsequent escalation of the dosage of a Schedule II opioid must also be prescribed by the physician. In accordance with the established mid-level practitioner prescribing protocol, the mid-level practitioner is approved to write maintenance prescriptions for a Schedule II opioid prescribed by the physician.
