Call to Order: 9:24 a.m.

With prior notice given in accordance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act, and with a quorum of fourteen members present, Board Chairman Howard J. Falgout, M.D., convened the public portion of the meeting of the Alabama State Board of Medical Examiners.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT Executive Director Sarah Moore reported on the following items: (1) The ongoing monitoring of several House and Senate bills that have the potential to impact the agency and the regulation of physicians; (2) Cooperative efforts with the Alabama Association of Regulatory Boards, direct contact with House and Senate members, and testifying before legislative committees concerning the legislation being monitored; (3) Meetings with Alabama Board of Pharmacy representatives regarding physician / pharmacist collaboration; (4) Meetings between the Executive Director and Associate Executive Director with Scott Harris, M.D., State Health Officer, concerning a contingency plan to make available to the Alabama Department of Mental Health, by county, a listing of all active physicians in the event of the mass arrest of physicians; (5) Meetings with Robert H. Moon, M.D., Medical Director, Alabama Department of Medicaid, and Kelli Newman, Pharm.D., Medicaid Director of Clinical Services / Pharmacy, concerning joint efforts to combat controlled substance abuse; (6) A report concerning the lease of office space for a satellite office in Birmingham; (7) The active search for a Senior Licensing Director; (8) A report on negotiated higher rates with the financial institutions utilized by the agency; and (9) as reported by the Associate Executive Director, William M. Perkins, a report on the purchase of updated computer equipment for Board members and staff.

QACSC CME: Conquering the Crisis: Fighting Substance Misuse in Alabama presented by the Auburn University Harrison School of Pharmacy The Credentials Committee recommended that the continuing medical education course be approved for QACSC renewal requirements. The motion was adopted without objection.

Scheduling of Tianeptine (Tianaa) The Credentials Committee recommended that the Alabama Department of Public Health be asked to conduct a due diligence study and to consider scheduling tianeptine as a controlled substance. The motion was adopted without objection.
