Public Minutes of May 19, 2022 The Credentials Committee recommended that the Public Minutes of May 19, 2022, be approved. The motion was adopted without objection.

### CURRENT BUSINESS

#### Administrative Rules for Publication

Administrative Rules, Chapters 540-X-12, 540-X-18, and 540-X-20, QACSC and LPSP The Credentials Committee recommended that proposed Administrative Rules, Chapter 540-X-12, *Qualified Alabama Controlled Substances Registration Certificate (QACSC)*, Chapter 540-X-18, *Qualified Alabama Controlled Substances Registration Certificate (QACSC) for Certified Registered Nurse Practitioners (CRNP) and Certified Nurse Midwives (CNM)* and Chapter 540-X-20, *Limited*

*Purpose Schedule II Permit (LPSP)*, as amended by the Committee to include additional grounds upon which applications may be declined for consideration, be approved for publication for public comment in the *Alabama Administrative Monthly*. The motion was adopted without objection.

#### Administrative Rules for Repeal

Administrative Rules, Chapter 540-X-16, The Practice of Medicine or Osteopathy Across State Lines The Credentials Committee recommended that the repeal of Administrative Rules, Chapter 540-X-16, *The Practice of Medicine or Osteopathy Across State Lines*, be approved for publication for public comment in the *Alabama Administrative Monthly*. The motion was adopted without objection.

#### Other

Appointment to the Athletic Trainer Advisory Council The Credentials Committee recommended the appointment of Beverly F. Jordan, M.D., to the Athletic Trainer Advisory Council for a three-year term commencing July 1, 2022, and expiring June 30, 2025, be approved. The motion was adopted without objection. Beverly F. Jordan, M.D., recused herself from discussion, deliberation, and determination.

Proposed Revisions to Chapter 540-X-11, Guidelines for the Use of Lasers and Other Modalities Affecting Living Tissue The Credentials Committee recommended deferring for discussion by the full Board to develop a work group to review and revise the rules.

After discussion by the full Board, a motion was made by Beverly F. Jordan, M.D., and was seconded by Charles M. A. Rogers, M.D., to convene a work group of Board members Julia L. Boothe, M.D., and Jane A. Weida, M.D., and other experts to review and revise Administrative

Rules, Chapter, 540-X-11, *Guidelines for the Use of Lasers and Other Modalities Affecting Living Tissue*. It was further recommended that communication be established with the Alabama Dental Board as the review process progresses. The motion was adopted without objection. Julia L. Boothe, M.D., and Jane A. Weida, M.D., recused themselves from discussion, deliberation, and determination.

USMLE Sponsorship After consideration of the United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE) Attempt Limit Policy, the Credentials Committee recommended that the Board not accept sponsorship requests from license applicants for additional USMLE Step attempts. The motion was adopted without objection.

Resolution: Joint Committee on Pharmacy Collaborative Practice The Credentials Committee recommended adoption of the Joint Resolution of the Board of Medical Examiners and Board of Pharmacy which negates the requirement for a 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter meeting of the Committee on Pharmacy Collaborative Practice. The motion was adopted without objection.




