Colon Hydrotherapy The Credentials Committee recommended notifying Mr. Kendall of the Board's definition of the practice of medicine within the state of Alabama and the Board's position that holistic medicine is not recognized, nor regulated, except as practiced by a licensed physician, and to notify him of the statute, effective September 1, 2007, which makes the unlicensed practice of medicine a Class C Felony. The motion was adopted.

Foundation for Medical Excellence The Credentials Committee recommended notifying Dr. Skipper that the Board of Medical Examiners is not authorized to make a monetary contribution to a private foundation. The motion was adopted.
