<u>Buprenorphine Summit – Opioid Response Network</u> The Credentials Committee recommended that the announcement of the Buprenorphine Summit hosted by the Opioid Response Network in partnership with the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners be received as information. The motion was adopted without objection.

ADPH Proposed Rules on Birthing Centers The Credentials Committee recommended approving staff to prepare comments in support of the proposed Alabama Department of Public Health Rules on Birthing Centers. The motion was adopted without objection.

ADPH Proposed Rules on Rural Emergency Hospitals The Credentials Committee recommended approving staff to prepare comments to the rules empathizing with the lack of access to emergency medicine in rural Alabama, and in an effort not to lower the standard of care for patients in Alabama, recommending that a physician be present at all times, suggesting procedures be developed for the transfer of patients in need of acute care, and recommending the public be made aware of the level of care that is available in a rural emergency hospital. The motion was adopted without objection.

<u>Cessation of Deferral Option for Licenses and Registrations</u> The Credentials Committee recommended that the option currently offered to applicants to defer the issuance of medical
