The motion was adopted without objection.

Administrative Rule 540-X-9-.11, Contact with Patients Before Prescribing The Credentials Committee recommended that the amendments to Administrative Rule 540-X-9-.11, *Contact with Patients Before Prescribing*, be approved for final adoption without any changes to the rule and that a response be provided to any comments received in opposition to the rule. The motion was adopted without objection.

Other

Alabama Medical Cannabis Certification Permit - Draft Application The Credentials Committee recommended approval of the Alabama Medical Cannabis Certification Permit application. The motion was adopted without objection.

Appointment to the Bridge Year Standing Work Group The Credentials Committee recommended that Jane A. Weida, M.D., be appointed to the Bridge Year Graduate Physician

Standing Work Group. The motion was adopted without objection. Jane A. Weida, M.D., recused herself from discussion, deliberation, and determination.

Appointment to the Chronic Weight Management and Type 2 Diabetes Task Force The Credentials Committee recommended that Jonathan D. Parker, D.O., be appointed to the Chronic Weight Management and Type 2 Diabetes Task Force. The motion was adopted without objection.

Buprenorphine Summit – Opioid Response Network The Credentials Committee recommended that the announcement of the Buprenorphine Summit hosted by the Opioid Response Network in partnership with the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners be received as information. The motion was adopted without objection.

ADPH Proposed Rules on Birthing Centers The Credentials Committee recommended approving staff to prepare comments in support of the proposed Alabama Department of Public Health Rules on Birthing Centers. The motion was adopted without objection.

ADPH Proposed Rules on Rural Emergency Hospitals The Credentials Committee recommended approving staff to prepare comments to the rules empathizing with the lack of access to emergency medicine in rural Alabama, and in an effort not to lower the standard of care for patients in Alabama, recommending that a physician be present at all times, suggesting procedures be developed for the transfer of patients in need of acute care, and recommending the public be made aware of the level of care that is available in a rural emergency hospital. The motion was adopted without objection.

Cessation of Deferral Option for Licenses and Registrations The Credentials Committee recommended that the option currently offered to applicants to defer the issuance of medical

licenses, Alabama Controlled Substances Certificates, Pain Management Registrations, and reinstated licenses to January 1 cease to be offered. The motion was adopted without objection.

Vehicle Policy The Credentials Committee recommended pursuant to Executive Order 728, the Agency Vehicle Policy be approved and be incorporated into the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners Employee Policy and Procedures Handbook. The motion was adopted without objection.

Proposed HIPAA Privacy Rule to Support Reproductive Health Care Privacy After consideration by the full Board, a motion was made by William J. Suggs, M.D., that was seconded by Amanda J. Williams, M.D., to approve staff to submit comments to the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) in opposition to the modification of the HIPAA privacy rule. The motion was adopted without objection.






