Items Pending Joint Committee Review

Orthopedic Specialty Protocol Proposed Revisions The Credentials Committee recommended deferring for a report from Charles M. A. Rogers, IV, M.D.

After consideration of a recommendation from the Joint Committee to approve revisions to the Orthopedic Specialty Protocol, a motion was made by Beverly F. Jordan, M.D., and seconded by Jane A. Weida, M.D., that the revised protocol be approved as presented with the recommendation to further amend the protocol by striking language limiting glenohumeral joint, ischiofemoral bursa, and intra-articular hip injections to specific specialty practices and striking

language limiting Sacroiliac (SI) joint out of protocol requests only to APPs within orthopedic practice settings. The motion was adopted without objection.

Adult Acute Care Standard Protocol Proposed Revision The Credentials Committee recommended deferring for a report from Charles M. A. Rogers, IV, M.D.

After consideration of a recommendation from the Joint Committee to amend the Adult Acute Care Standard Protocol to add: "Initiate and manage therapeutic TPN to include writing the formula," the motion was adopted without objection.

Retirement of Flex PRN Pool Protocol & Limited Protocol for Long Term Care Facilities The Credentials Committee recommended deferring for a report from Charles M. A. Rogers, IV, M.D.

After consideration of a recommendation from the Joint Committee to retire the Flex PRN Pool Protocol and Limited Protocol for Long Term Care Facilities and grandfathering in any currently authorized CRNPs and CNMs practicing under the protocols, the motion was adopted without objection.

Request for Reconsideration of Monthly Chart Review Restart (Dr. Tanner Grant) The Credentials Committee recommended deferring for a report from Charles M. A. Rogers, IV, M.D.

After consideration of a recommendation from the Joint Committee to approve amending rules to eliminate the requirement for 6 months' monthly QA when collaborations exceed 4 FTEs, while retaining the quarterly QA review requirement, the motion was adopted without objection.

Consideration for Publication – Board Rule 540-X-8-.02 Terms and Functions of the Joint Committee The Credentials Committee recommended deferring for a report from Charles M. A. Rogers, IV, M.D.

After consideration of a recommendation from the Joint Committee to approve, the amendments to Administrative Rule 540-X-8-.02 as revised by the Committee, and to publish the rule for public comment in the *Alabama Administrative Monthly*, the motion was adopted without objection.

Admin. Code R. 540-X-25) be denied. The motion was adopted without objection.

State Committee of Public Health Notice Regarding State Rescheduling of Medical Marijuana Products in Accordance with Federal Rescheduling by DEA The Credentials Committee recommended that the Board decline to submit comments or provide testimony at the July 22,

2026, Alabama Department of Public Health public hearing regarding the rescheduling of medical marijuana products. The motion was adopted without objection.

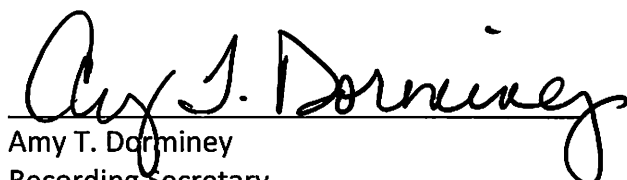

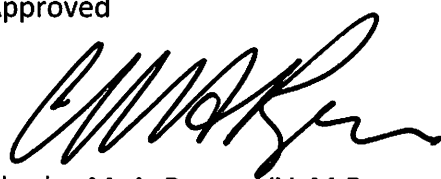

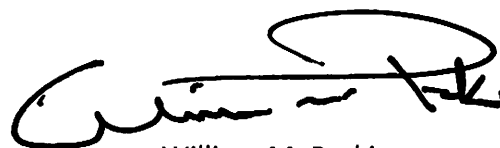
