Collaborative Practice Continuing Medical Education The Credentials Committee recommended deferring for a report from the Joint Committee.

Dr. Boothe reported that the Joint Committee did not approve the request from the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners (ALBME) requesting that the Alabama Board of Nursing

(ABON) accept the attendance of a CRNP or a CNM at the collaborative and supervisory practice continuing medical education course, jointly sponsored by the ALBME and the Medical Association of the State of Alabama, to meet the ongoing educational requirement for practice within a collaboration or, in the alternative, the ABON consider a CRNP or a CNM who has completed the course thus far to be compliant with the initial continuing education requirement that is effective on January 1, 2024, for CRNPs and CNMs.

Modification of Standard Protocols (Laser Protocols for Non-Ablative Treatment) The Credentials Committee recommended deferring for a report from the Joint Committee.

Dr. Boothe reported that the Joint Committee did not approve the request by the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners requesting that the Alabama Board of Nursing (ABON) amend the applicable CRNP standard protocols to add language referencing the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners' Administrative Rules Chapter 540-X-11, *Guidelines for the Use of Lasers and Other Modalities Affecting Living Tissue*.

Critical Care Specialty Protocol – Annual Maintenance Procedures The Credentials Committee recommended deferring for a report from the Joint Committee.




