FINAL ORDER

This matter comes before the Medical Licensure Commission of Alabama for hearing on October 27, 2021 on the Alabama State Board of Medical Examiners' contest to the reinstatement of the medical license of Charles Randall Thompson ("Dr. Thompson"), by Order of August 11, 2021, in the above-styled cause. Dr. Thompson having been duly notified in accordance with the *Alabama Administrative Procedures Act*, was present, was represented by counsel, and presented testimony. The Alabama Board of Medical Examiners ("ABME") appeared through counsel and presented evidence.

FINDING

From the evidence submitted at said October 27, 2021 hearing (ABME Exhibits 1-8 and sworn testimony of Dr. Thompson), the Medical Licensure Commission of Alabama finds as follows:

- 1. The evidence was insufficient to conclude Dr. Thompson was guilty of Count One (Inability To Practice Medicine With Reasonable Skill And Safety To Patients As A Result Of Any Mental Or Physical Condition), a violation of *Ala. Code* § 34-24-360(19); Count Three (Distribution By Prescribing, Dispensing, Furnishing, Or Supplying Of Controlled Substances To Any Person Or Patient For Any Reason Other Than Legitimate Medical Purposes), a violation of *Ala. Code* § 34-24-360(8); and Count Four (Unprofessional Conduct), a violation of *Ala. Code* § 34-24-360(2); and
- 2. Dr. Thompson failed to maintain for a patient a medical record that meets minimum standards, a violation of Ala. Code § 34-24- 360(22).

CONCLUSIONS

Based on these findings, the Commission concludes as follows:

Dr. Charles Randall Thompson failed to maintain for a patient a medical record that meets minimum standards as charged in Count Two of the May

7, 2021 Administrative Complaint.

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact, the Medical Licensure Commission concludes, as a matter of law, that Dr. Thompson has failed to comply with a rule of the Board of Medical Examiners or Medical Licensure Commission, a violation of Ala. Code § 34-24-360(22).

DETERMINATION

It is therefore ORDERED that the April 9, 2021 contest to the reinstatement of the medical license of Charles Randall Thompson, M.D., by the Alabama State Board of Medical Examiners is DENIED, said application for reinstatement of Dr. Thompson's medical license is GRANTED, and the license to practice medicine in Alabama of the Respondent, Charles R. Thompson, M.D., be and the same is hereby REPRIMANDED.

ORDER

This matter comes before the Medical Licensure Commission of Alabama for a probation compliance hearing on October 27, 2021, by Order of September 29, 2021, in the above-styled cause. Dr. Kathleen A. Cullen having been duly notified in accordance with the *Alabama Administrative Procedures Act*, was not present and was not represented by counsel. The Alabama Board of Medical Examiners appeared through counsel and presented evidence.

FINDING

From the evidence submitted at said October 27, 2021 hearing, the Medical Licensure Commission of Alabama finds as follows:

- 1. By Order of the Medical Licensure Commission of Alabama, dated February 24, 2021, Dr. Cullen was fined Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) and her license to practice medicine in the State of Alabama was revoked. The revocation was stayed, and her license was placed on probation subjected to the following:
 - Successful completion of a medical education course on medical ethics, approved by the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners, within six months of February 24, 2021 (i.e., August 24, 2021); and
 - b. Payment of the \$10,000 fine accessed within said six-month period.
- 2. Roland K. Johnson, Director of Physicians Monitoring Program testified that Dr. Cullen has neither paid the \$10,000 fine nor completed a medical education course on medical ethics.

3. Mr. Johnson further testified that Dr. Cullen was aware of the hearing and the requirement she attend the hearing in person.

CONCLUSIONS

Based on these findings, the Commission concludes as follows:

Dr. Kathleen A. Cullen is not compliant with the terms of probation set forth in the February 24, 2021 Order of the Commission.

DETERMINATION

It is therefore ORDERED that the February 24, 2021 Stay of Revocation is hereby LIFTED and Dr. Kathleen A. Cullen's license to practice medicine in the State of Alabama is REVOKED.
