Based on these findings, the Commission concludes as follows:



Based upon the foregoing findings of fact, the Medical Licensure Commission concludes, as a matter of law, that Dr. Thompson has failed to comply with a rule of the Board of Medical Examiners or Medical Licensure Commission, a violation of Ala. Code § 34-24- 360(22).

DETERMINATION

It is therefore ORDERED that the April 9, 2021 contest to the reinstatement of the medical license of Charles Randall Thompson, M.D., by the Alabama State Board of Medical Examiners is DENIED, said application for reinstatement of Dr. Thompson's medical license is GRANTED, and the license to practice medicine in Alabama of the Respondent, Charles R. Thompson, M.D., be and the same is hereby REPRIMANDED.
