

Proposed Rule Revision for Consideration at the March 26, 2025 Meeting of the Medical Licensure Commission of Alabama

545-X-1-.02 Officers Of The Commission.

- (1) The Commission shall elect from its members a chairman and a vice chairman. The election of officers shall be held annually at the regular monthly meeting of the Commission held in June of each year. The officers so elected shall take office immediately upon adjournment of the meeting at which they are elected. No person shall be elected as chairman for more than five consecutive terms.
 - (2) The duties of the officers shall be as follows:
- (a) The chairman shall preside at meetings of the Commission and appoint members to serve on such committees as may be created.
- (b) The vice chairman shall preside in the absence of the chairman and shall assume the duties of the chairman when necessary.
- (c) The chairman shall have the authority to take such action in the absence of the Commission that is necessary for the continuance of the day-to-day operation of the Commission and its staff. Such acts shall include scheduling of hearings, rulings on motions, requests and objections as they may relate to the admission or non-admission of evidence or testimony at hearings, and making determinations as to the order of evidence to be taken at hearings.
- (d) The chairman shall preside over the meetings and hearings of the Commission and, with the aid of counsel, shall rule on procedural and evidentiary issues which may arise during the course of hearings. The chairman may delegate such portions of said responsibility as he may deem fit.

- 1. Name of Employer: Southeastern Plastic Surgery Associates, P.C., 100 Towncenter Blvd, Suite 111, Tuscaloosa, AL 35406
 - a. Owner/President Luis Ronald Pernia, M.D.
 - b. Southeastern Plastic Surgery and Robert Bolling agree that a chaperone shall be physically present in the same room with Robert Bolling and the patient for the full duration of all patient encounters (including participating during telemedicine encounters), with continuous, direct visual and aural observation of all activities. Additionally, all chaperones used for these purposes shall be employed by Southeastern Plastic Surgery, and all chaperones shall have successfully completed the PBI Medical Chaperone Training Program.
 - c. Dr. Pernia will provide general physician supervision of Dr. Bolling for general office visits or evaluation and management services for a minimum of six months, and longer if required for Dr. Pernia to be satisfied with Dr. Bolling's clinical competence. Dr. Pernia will initially provide direct physician supervision of Dr. Bolling for the procedures set forth in Paragraph 2.d. below until Dr. Pernia is satisfied with Dr. Bolling's clinical competence.
 - d. Scope of Practice: General Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. This will include both the inpatient and outpatient treatment of these patients. Initially, Dr. Bolling will practice in the office setting until he is able to obtain hospital privileges. Dr Pernia is willing to sponsor Dr. Bolling or assist Dr. Bolling with Dr. Bolling's hospital medical staff membership application as appropriate according to the individual hospital's medical staff membership process. For a minimum of six months, and longer if required for Dr. Pernia to be satisfied with Dr. Bolling's clinical competence, Dr. Pernia will accompany Dr. Bolling in the operating room during any surgical procedures. Dr. Bolling's ability to operate independently in the operating room will also depend on the policies and procedures of the Hospitals' medical staff and operating room credentialing committee or surgical staff committee.
 - e. Days/Hours of Work: Work hours excluding call, will be limited initially to 45 hours per week.
 - f. Patient population: The patient population will include males and females of all ages from the surrounding areas.
- 2. Monitoring, Mentoring and Competency:

- a. Preceptor/Proctor: Luis Ronald Pernia, M.D. Board Certified by the American Board of Plastic Surgery (ABPS).
- b. Dr. Bolling and Dr. Pernia agree to follow these parameters. Dr. Luis Pernia, a diplomat of the American Board of Plastic Surgery, will serve as the designated local proctor for the duration of Dr. Bolling's Preceptorship. This will include the supervision of office patients as well as inpatient and output surgical procedures.
 - i. Medical knowledge: Dr. Pernia will review Dr. Bolling's patient interaction, quality and care provided by Dr. Bolling. Dr. Pernia's evaluation(s) will be provided to the Medical License Commission once completed.
 - ii. Patient Care: a case log will be maintained for at least the first year. Evaluation and Management skills as well as surgical skills will be assessed monthly and included in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A and shall be provided to the Medical License Commission.
 - iii. Communication skills: after having returned to practice for three months, Dr. Bolling will participate in a 360 evaluation by the Southeastern Plastic Surgery office personnel. Evaluations will be provided to the Medical License Commission.
 - iv. Practice-Based Learning: Upon the conclusion of the first 12 months of practice, Dr. Bolling will complete a Tracer Procedure for his most commonly performed procedure and submit the report to the Medical Licensure Commission.
- c. Dr. Pernia will oversee and assess the six core competencies of medical knowledge; patient care; professionalism; communication skills; practice based learning; and systems-based practice. Dr. Pernia agrees to submit monthly evaluation forms to the Medical License Commission in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A. Dr. Pernia also agrees to provide the Medical Licensure Commission with quarterly monitoring reports that provide a general summary of the number of patients treated and types of cases performed by Dr. Bolling.

d. Outcomes Assessment

i. Dr. Pernia will provide direct physician supervision of cosmetic injectable patients to determine Dr. Bolling's clinical competence with the patients' evaluation and treatment. These patients will be recorded in a log with Dr. Pernia's assessment of informed consent, safety, technique, competency, sterile technique, clinical skills, and outcome. After a minimum of six months, and longer if required for Dr. Pernia to be satisfied with Dr. Bolling's clinical competence with performing cosmetic injectable procedures, Dr. Bolling will be allowed to treat these patients under Dr. Pernia's general physician supervision.

- ii. Dr. Pernia will provide direct physician supervision of office procedures such as skin lesion excision, skin cancer removal and wound care debridement to determine Dr. Bolling's clinical competence with the patients' evaluation and treatment. These patients will be recorded in a log with Dr. Pernia's assessment of informed consent, safety, technique, competency, sterile technique, clinical skills, and outcome. After a minimum of six months, and longer if required for Dr. Pernia to be satisfied with Dr. Bolling's clinical competence with performing these procedures, Dr. Bolling will be allowed to see treat these patients under Dr. Pernia's general physician supervision.
- e. Materials to be submitted to the MLC
 - i. Monthly evaluations in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A,
 - ii. Patient/procedure case logs for referenced in Paragraph 2.d. above in the form attached hereto as Exhibit B,
 - iii. Quarterly Monitoring Reports,
 - iv. Final Letter of recommendation from Dr. Pernia,
 - v. Final evaluation from Dr. Pernia, and
 - vi. Additional materials as requested by the MLC based on individual situations
- 3.
