IMPORTANT: Attention CRNPs and PAs

Are your covering physicians covering for your QACSC and/or LPSP?

Follow the steps below to determine if a covering physician is listed on your QACSC and/or LPSP:

1. Go to www.albme.gov
2. Click on Licensee Gateway
3. If you do not have an account, you must Register for the Licensee Gateway. Select the **red** Register icon to create a username and password.
4. Once logged in, you will see your associated QACSC/LPSP registrations under My Licenses/Registrations. Covering physicians should be listed.

For a covering physician to be added to your QACSC/LPSP, they first must be a covering physician under your collaborative/registration agreement. To add a covering physician under your collaborative/registration agreement, submit a completed covering physician agreement, [Covering Physician Agreement APP.pdf](#), to APPDept@albme.gov. Once the physician is a covering on your collaborative/registration agreement, they may be added to your QACSC and/or LPSP by following the steps listed below. There is no fee to add a covering physician.

Follow the steps below to add a covering physician to your QACSC and/or LPSP:

- Complete the QACSC and/or LPSP covering physician agreement form:

- CRNPs: To find your Collaborative Practice (CP) number,
 - Go to [License Lookup | Alabama Board of Medical Examiners and Medical Licensure Commission](#).
 - Enter your collaborating physician's first and last name only, then select "search".
 - Find your name.
 - The license # displayed is the CP#. This number can also be found on the CP certificate issued to the collaborating physician.
- PAs: To find your Registration Agreement (RA) number, go to [License Lookup | Alabama Board of Medical Examiners and Medical Licensure Commission](#) and search using your name and selecting "RA" as the license type. The license # displayed is the RA#. PAs can also log into their Licensee Gateway to find this number. It is located under My Licenses/Registrations.
- Completed QACSC/LPSP covering agreement forms can be emailed to QACSC@albme.gov.
- Once the covering physician agreements are approved, the covering physician will be listed under your QACSC and/or LPSP in your Licensee Gateway account.
